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Dear Parents:

According to State Law, every student that rides a district school bus must be trained and show competence in seven areas of safety and conduct. The seven competencies that students must know and understand are: 1) Transportation by bus is a privilege and not a right; 2) The danger zones surrounding a school bus; 3) Proper bus stop behavior; 4) Safe boarding and leaving a bus; 5) Bus riding rules; 6) Pedestrian safety rules; and 7) Bus emergency procedures.

We will be providing the necessary information and training for students to know and understand these concepts. By State Law, students not able to demonstrate and apply the above competencies, are subject to having their transportation privileges denied.
